

Annotated Bibliography

You will compose an annotated bibliography that consists of the sources you have chosen to use for your persuasive writing assignment.

Guidelines:

Remember that an annotated bibliography consists of these three parts:

- **Summary:** What is each source about? What is the author's/organization's main idea? Which points do the author/organization use to support their main idea?
 - **Assessment:** What is the author's/organization's purpose for composing the text? Is the author/organization biased or objective? What are the author's/organization's credentials? (Are they a reliable source?)
 - **Reflection:** How does this source contribute to your work? Does it support your position, or does it support the opposition? Has this source taught you something about your topic that you didn't already know?
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- Use the same format that is presented in the sample.
 - You must have at least **three** sources.
