2. Be sure to cover all material required by the prompt. This prompt is a complicated one, to be sure. If you carefully break down the prompt, you will see that it is asking for you to:

- a. discuss the problem,
- b. propose a solution to the problem,
- c. evaluate the validity, reliability, and biases of the sources you used in addition to pointing out where more research is needed, and
- d. show ethical implications of your proposed solution.

3. Develop your paragraphs more. Your paragraphs are presenting information, but they do not seem to "say" anything. Each paragraph should develop the argument for your solution to the problem. In general, all paragraphs need to have 3 pieces:

P-Point—also known as your topic sentence where you state what the paragraph is about

I-Information—where you present your information (facts, details, quotes, and reasons)

E-Explanation—where you explain the relevance or importance of your information
